CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION: Applicant *must* fit one of the following criteria:

Graduating high school senior with plans for higher education and is a member of St. Timothy's Episcopal Church.

Enrolled undergraduate or graduate student in a certified institution of higher learning who previously attended St. Timothy's Episcopal Church within the last six years. Undergraduate or graduate students can only apply for assistance ONCE every school year.

Current OFFICIAL academic transcript (*sealed envelope from your school*) - applicable to High School/Undergraduate/Graduate applicants

Two letters of reference (*High School applicant only*)

Theme interpretation – essay, poem or song (*High School applicant only*)

Signed financial agreement (*High School applicant only*)

Statement of need (*Undergraduate/Graduate applicant only*)
